Q: What is the North Central Reading Council (NCRC) Literacy Grant?
A: One of NCRCs goals is to promote literacy and we are thrilled to offer grant money to you, our members, to help reach that goal! Members interested in the grant may apply for up to \$250 to be used to promote literacy.

Q: Who is eligible to apply for the NCRC Literacy Grant?

A: Any current NCRC member is encouraged to apply. Librarians, school staff, or building committees are welcome and encouraged to head up the project/plan, however, NCRC is only able to grant funds for students in classrooms of teachers who are, in fact, NCRC members.

Q: How do I apply?

A: Complete the North Central Reading Council Literacy Grant Application. As you complete your application, **please keep in mind your project/plan should:**

- Demonstrate innovative thinking
- Promote literacy
- Have a direct and immediate impact on the largest amount of students

Q: When is the application deadline?

A: Completed applications must be sent via email to <u>heather.ell@minot.k12.nd.us</u> with the subject "NCRC GRANT APPLICATION" no later than **Thursday, October 29, 2015**.

Q: When will the grant be awarded?

A: Each grant application will be reviewed and decided upon by the NCRC Officers. A total of \$1000 in awarded funds will be administered to approved applicants (a maximum of \$250 per award). **Notifications will be made by the end of December.**

Q: Do I need to do any follow up on the project?

A: Yes, we are asking grant recipients to summarize the project and send photos to be used on the NCRC Website and Facebook page to promote literacy!
